

## Kidsponcho in Eliza



### Material

**Yarn:** Scheepjes Eliza, 2 balls white nr. 218, 1 ball pink nr. 228

**Needles and hooks:** straight knitting needles 4 mm. 40 cm circular knitting needles 4,5 mm. crochet hook 7 mm.

**Gauge:** 19 sts/10 cm when knitting the pattern.

**Size:** The reluctant model just turned 5 years old and is 104 cm tall.

### Pattern repeat

Always lift first stitch, either knitwise or purlwise depending on the row.

**Row 1 with pink:** Purl

**Row 2 with white:** knit

**Row 3 and 5 with white:** purl

**Row 6 with pink:** knit 2 \*drop next st, and let it go 4 rows down (all white rows) and pick up the stitch from row 4 (pink) with left knitting needle (the loose threads should be behind the work) and knit it, knit 3\* repeat for the rest of the row, but knit 2 instead of knit 3 in the

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end.

**Row 7 with pink:** purl

**Row 8 and 10 with white:** Knit

**Row 9 and 11 with white:** purl

**Row 12 with pink:** Knit 4 \* drop next st, and let it go 4 rows down (all white rows) and pick up the stitch from row 4 (pink) with left knitting needle (the loose threads should be behind the work) and knit it, knit 2\* end row with knit 1.


### **Start:**

The idea is very simple: Knit two rectangular pieces 26\*60 cm and sew them together. Pick up stitches for the collar and knit ribbing. Crochet along border. Done!

Cast on 53 stitches (the pattern should be multiple of 4+1) with pink.

Knit the pattern repeat 60 cm. I recommend you to count every row and I had to knit the 12 rows of the pattern repeat 18 times to get 60 cm. Make another.

Sew the two pieces together according to picture.



**Collar:** With circular needles and pink yarn, pick up 74 sts around the neck and knit ribbing; k1, p1 27 rounds. Change to white and make one more round of k1, p1. Cast off loosely.

**Bottom edge:** With crochet hook 7 mm and white yarn held double:

**Round 1:** approx. 194 sc around and 3 sc in each corner. It can be a bit tricky to get the big

hook into the stitches on the edge, so I did mine a bit further in, and I think it still looks ok.  
**Round 2:** Scalloped edge: Ch 3, 2 dc in same st. \*skip 1 st, 1 sc in next, skip 1 st, 5 dc in next st. \* Repeat until 3 sts remains Skip 1 st, 1 sc in next, skip 1 st, 2 dc in same st that you made chain 3 and 2 dc.

Weave in all ends. Done!
