

Louise - Cowl



It's lovely that fall is getting here and with that all cosy clothes and accessories. Stonewashed XL (especially the white one) has an almost snowy feel to it and is so soft on you body that I had to make a cowl from it. I tried it on my 6-year old who loved it so I had to make another one for myself!

Material

Yarn: Scheepjes Stonewashed XL, 1 ball in each following color: White 841 (Moonstone) and Turquoise 855 (Green agate) for the white/turquoise cowl, or 1 ball o each following color White 841 (Moonstone) and pink (Tourmaline) 876 for the white/pink one.

Knitting needles: Circular needles, 40 cm long in sizes 4 mm and 5 mm.

Gauge: 14 stitches on 10 cm with stockinette stitch.

Size: Fits adults who wants a snug cowl and for kids, 5 years and up.

Other stuff: 1 stitchmarker to mark start of round and a yarnneedle to sew in ends with.

Pattern Bubbles

Row 1 with white: Knit

Row 2-5 with turquoise: knit

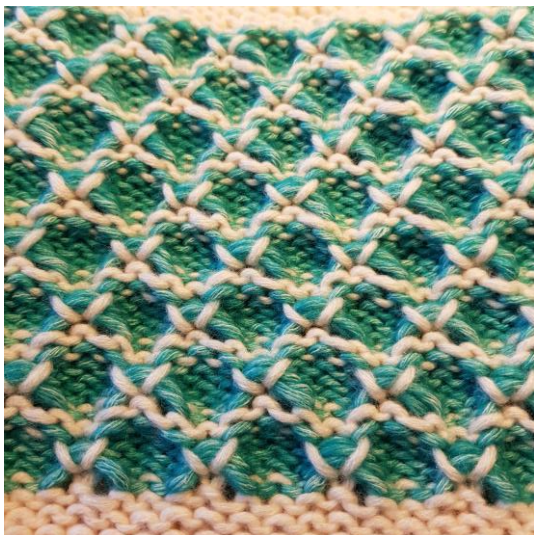
Row 6 with white: *knit 3, drop next st, and let it go 4 rows down (all the turquoise rows) and pick up the stitch from row 4 (white) with left knitting needle (the loose threads should be behind the work and become wrapped around the knitted stitch, see pic of the back) and knit it, knit 3*. Repeat *-* until end of round.

Row 7 with white: knit

Row 8-11 with turquoise: Knit

Row 12 with white: Knit 1 * drop next st, and let it go 4 rows down (all turquoise rows) and pick up the stitch from row 4 (white) with left knitting needle (the loose threads should be behind the work, wrapped around the knitted stitch) and knit it, knit 2*. Repeat *-* until end of round.

The back should look like this (almost prettier than the front!):



Start:

With circular needles 4 mm and white yarn, cast on 68 stitches and knit garterstitch for 5 rounds. Since we're knitting in the round it will be like this (start with a purl-round):

Purl, knit, purl, knit, purl

Change to knitting needles 5 mm and knit according to above pattern until work measures approximately 16 cm (or longer if you prefer a larger cowl, but keep in mind that you might need more yarn then). End with a row 1 or 7.

Change to needles 4 mm and knit an edge of garterstitch again: purl, knit, purl, knit, purl. Cast off on a knit row. Cut yarn and sew in ends.
