

Heart cowl



Little kids always need cozy cowls and they're such a fun and quick knit. Of course I had to make one with hearts on in February!

The yarn I've used is made of Merinowool and acrylicblend is very soft against the skin.

Material

Yarn: 1 ball each in the following colors of Scheepjes Merino soft: 622 (color A), 623 (color B) and 621 (color C).

Knitting needles: 40 cm long circular needles, size 4,0 mm.

Gauge: Approximately 19 sts/10 cm.

Storlek: For kids about age 4.

Övriga tillbehör: Stitchmarker for beginning of round, scissors and needle to sew in ends.

Start:


Cast on 90 stitches with color A and circular needles 4,0 mm. You can change the size by adding or subtracting 10 stitches at the time.

The cowl is knit in the round.

Knit the ribbing for 15 rounds: *knit 1 through back loop, purl 1*.

Change to color B and knit one round.

Follow heartpattern, rounds 1-13 one time and rounds 2-13 one time. NOTE: the X with a circle on round 13, should not count the second time of round 13, this stitch is then knit with color A the second time of round 13. (It's the beginning of a new heart and as there will be no more heart after, it looks better omitting it.)



Knit one round with color B.

Change to color A and knit ribbing for 15 rounds: *knit 1 through back loop, purl 1*.

Cast off loosely and sew in threads.
